Students follow four compulsory courses and one elective

TRIMESTER 3

### MA THESIS, CAPSTONE CASE STUDY AND ONE ELECTIVE

In addition to advancing their MA Thesis and working on a Capstone project, students take one elective which could be an internship.

- Intensive Capstone - 9 ECTS

- Internship - 6 ECTS (only for students with 90-credit option)
